Talbot Sports Turf specialises in installing turf onto sports surfaces either during the playing season or the closed season, also carrying out renovation work including seeding etc.

We can install turf in varying widths including 16", 21", 24", 29", 42" and 48" depending on the customer's choice of turf and preference. This can be in the form of either washed turf, rootzone turf, fibre turf or soil based turf, again depending on either the customer's or agronomist's requirements or indeed the application for which it is required.

We now offer a world beating 2.5 metre wide roll, the only company to have this facility giving the client the flexibility to specify turf from any grower in the world. This, in turn, ensures our machinery and resources for carrying out any installation project are second to none.

With a wealth of knowledge and practical experience, employees at Talbot Sports Turf are able to work to the standard required and carry out the contract in the time allowed.

We have invested heavily in machinery and developed methods to install a full pitch of 40mm thick turf or to refurbish goalmouths and to carry out end of season renovations. This means we are able to ensure the contract is carried out to the customer's requirements.





Renovation

Talbot Sports Turf works closely with all the major turf/seed producers throughout the world. This enables us to select turf/seed of the highest standard and most suitable for the application it is required for.

The turf or seed is carefully selected from cultivars that have the best characteristics and those tested by S.T.R.I at Bingley, Yorkshire.

It must be remembered that turf or seed is a living product and therefore must be treated as perishable goods. We have the experience to renovate soil pitches, sand pitches, fibre reinforced pitches, SISgrass or Desso pitches together with hybrid carpet systems.

Turf Installation

The turf is installed using two machines both designed by and specific to Talbot Sports Turf.

These are the "Talbot Turf Porter IV" installer, capable of laying turf in big roll form and varying widths from 21" to 48". It has a self unroll facility to prevent stretching of the turf and damaging of the root system.

We then use the "Talbot Easi Knit". This ensures that all turf is butted up sufficiently which helps the new turf to knit together quickly to achieve a superior playing surface. During the installation process we are in control of the turf deliveries and are inspecting and monitoring turf when it arrives and checking each roll on installation.





Maintenance and Agronomy

Talbot Sports Turf use independent agronomists to advise on the condition and quality of works on completion and to advise our client on any short-term future maintenance requirements that they feel are necessary.

This service is carried out using one of our largest and most respected agronomy companies in the UK.



Talbot Sports Turf are able to carry out the construction or reconstruction of any type of playing surface, or carry out complete returfs for immediate use or goal mouth repairs to any sports surface of any standard anywhere in the world, whether hybrid, reinforced, rootzone, sand or soil.





Stitched hybrid pitch systems


